

Code of Conduct – specific to Parents/Carers of Juniors

Beddington Cricket Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well-being of all its members. It is expected that that Parents and Carers will abide to the following rules at all times.

Parents and Carers should:

- 1. Encourage your child to learn the laws of the game and play within them
- 2. Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials
- 3. Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results
- 4. Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all
- 5. Publicly accept officials' judgements
- 6. Use correct and proper language at all times
- 7. Make the club aware of any physical, psychological, or emotional difficulties your child may have
- 8. Be responsible for your child being on time and being picked up on time
- 9. Remind your child to follow the Junior Code of Conduct at all times
- 10. Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport
